7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.	 Breakfast	Breakfast is served at the conference venue.
8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.	 Registration Confirmation	Confirmed guests board their respective buses.
8:30 a.m.	 Departure	Buses depart from the conference venue.
8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.	 Guided Tour	Guests enjoy a narrated drive from Toronto to Niagara Falls, led by expert local tour guides, who will share some regional history and insights along the way.
10:00 a.m.	 Arrival in Niagara Falls	Guests meet their dedicated group guides, scan their digital QR codes for expedited entry, and receive ponchos (lightweight, hooded raincoats) before boarding.
10:20 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.	 City Cruises Boat Ride	Guests experience the iconic boat voyage out to the base of the falls, getting close enough to feel the mist and hear the thundering roar of the water.
11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.	 Clifton Hill Exploration	Guests explore Clifton Hill, discovering the vibrant shops, world-famous attractions and lively entertainment at the heart of the Niagara streetscape.
12:00 p.m.	 Boarding of Buses	Guests board the buses for lunch.
12:15 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.	 Lunch at Fallsview Restaurant	Guests enjoy a locally sourced and internationally inspired lunch at a restaurant featuring a breathtaking view of Niagara Falls.
2:15 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.	 Travel to Niagara-on-the-Lake	Guests enjoy a scenic drive down the historic Niagara Parkway, admiring the lush landscapes, winding river views, and beautiful floral gardens along the way.
3:00 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.	 Niagara-on-the-Lake Guided Tour	Guests participate in a guided tour through the historic streets of Niagara-on-the-Lake, enjoy local shopping, and savour a classic Canadian BeaverTails pastry.
4:15 p.m.	 Boarding of Buses	Guests board their respective buses for the return journey.
4:30 p.m. to 6:15 p.m.	 Return Transfer	Buses return to downtown Toronto.
6:15 p.m.	 Estimated Arrival in Toronto	Buses drop off guests at the conference venue.
