

IAEA 2026 Terms and Conditions

1. Registration Terms

- a. By completing your registration, you agree to abide by the policies outlined below by the organizing committee of the IAEA 2026 Annual Conference. The Organizing Committee of the IAEA 2026 Annual Conference is made of EQAO, in partnership with the International Association for Educational Assessment (IAEA) and Vretta.
- b. Your registration is valid only upon full payment and receipt of confirmation

2. Payment Policy

- a. All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration using the payment methods provided.
- b. Prices are listed in US Dollars (USD) and are subject to applicable taxes.
- c. You will receive a receipt upon successful payment.

3. Cancellation and Refund Policy

- a. You may cancel your registration **on or before June 27, 2026** and receive a full refund minus a US\$100 processing fee.
- b. All refund requests must be submitted in writing to info@iaea2026.org within the eligible cancellation period.
- c. Approved refunds will be processed within 10 business days of confirmation.
- d. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after June 27, 2026, including for any additional services (e.g., excursions or add-ons).
- e. If the conference is cancelled by the organizers, full refunds will be issued to all registrants, regardless of date.

4. Substitution Policy

- a. If you are unable to attend, you may nominate a substitute to attend in your place. Please contact us at info@iaea2026.org to request a substitution.

5. Liability Disclaimer Policy

- a. You are attending the Conference at your own risk. The organizing committee makes no express or implied representation or warranty with respect to the Conference, including without limitation with respect to the truth or accuracy of any exhibits or content presented at the Conference.
- b. In no event shall the organizing committee be liable to you for any consequential, incidental, indirect, or punitive damages, economic loss, loss of business, loss of products, incidental loss, anticipated profits, revenue or use, regardless of whether such liability results from breach of contract, breach of warranties, tort, strict liability or otherwise in connection with the Conference
- c. The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes to the event program, schedule, speakers, or venue at any time.
- d. The organizing committee is not responsible for any personal or financial losses resulting from changes, delays, or cancellations.

- c. This information will be used for the purposes of hosting the IAEA Conference and providing you information in connection with the Conference. You will be provided the opportunity to unsubscribe from messages provided to you in connection with the Conference.
